

How to Apply Online

- Click on the “Apply Now” link on the program of interest.
- There will be an active link to the program’s application.
- By clicking on this link, you will be directed to webstar.nova.edu
- If you have an account (you are/have been an NSU student or you have applied to other programs), log into WebStar. If you have forgotten your log in information, please contact NSU’s Help Desk at 1-800-541-6682, extension 24357. The program office does not have access to your Login or PIN information.
- If you do not have an account on Webstar, click on the ‘First Time User Account Creation’ button.
- Once you are logged in, you will be given the choice between Undergraduate and Graduate/Professional. Please click on ‘Graduate/Professional Programs.’ *
- You will then see a list of NSU Colleges and Schools. Click on ‘Shepard Broad Law Center.’
- You will then have the option of selecting an application type. Please select the program you are applying to (Certificate or Master of Science in Education Law, Master of Science in Employment Law OR Master of Science in Health Law).
- Follow the step by step instructions to complete the application.
