

SUPERVISED RESEARCH REGISTRATION FORM

You must read the following information before registering for Supervised Research.

A student may register for Supervised Research during fall or winter semester or during a regular summer session. Students cannot add Supervised Research after the end of the drop/add period. Students may drop Supervised Research through the end of the second week of classes for a regular semester (the drop period for Supervised Research in summer terms will be twice as long as the drop period for other classes).

Only currently employed full-time faculty members, including visiting faculty members, can supervise Supervised Research.

No student may earn more than two (2) credit hours for Supervised Research.

No full-time student may enroll in Supervised Research for a summer term until he/she has completed at least three (3) semesters of law school; no part-time student may enroll in Supervised Research for a summer term until he/she has completed at least four (4) semesters of law school.
